What is Zoom?

Zoom is a cloud-based video conferencing service you can use to virtually meet with others - either by video or audio-only or both, all while conducting live chats - and it lets you record those sessions to view later.

Zoom client installation.

Go to <https://zoom.us/download>, **download the Zoom client** version suitable for your device and your operating system. Then follow the instructions in the short [video](#) to install.

Signing up.

It is **necessary to sign up and have a Zoom account** so that you can join the Zoom events (talks) and to have an access to shared recordings of talks. To create your Zoom account, visit <https://zoom.us/freesignup> . It is free of charge.

Joining a Zoom event.

Click on the link provided by organizers of the conference, click on the “Join” button if you have already signed in Zoom or click on the “Register“ button, sign in to your Zoom account and then you can join the event.
